The Adopt-A-Family (AAF) Program pairs Bringing Hope Home supporters with real families that are struggling due to a cancer diagnosis and are in need over the holiday. It is a wonderful way to come together and remember the true meaning of the holidays-to give back and help others.

Adopt-A-Family Amazingness

Since the AAF Program began in 2011, over \$850,000 has been raised to help pay household bills for local families with cancer. In addition:

- Over **1,000 local families** have been assisted with gifts and gift cards
- Over **525 companies, departments, groups and individuals** have come together to support the AAF Program.
- Over **\$720,000** worth of gifts and gift cards have been provided to our families.
- Over **325 volunteers** have helped to organize, wrap and deliver all of the items to each family for the holiday.

1 Help a Family Pay Their Bills
