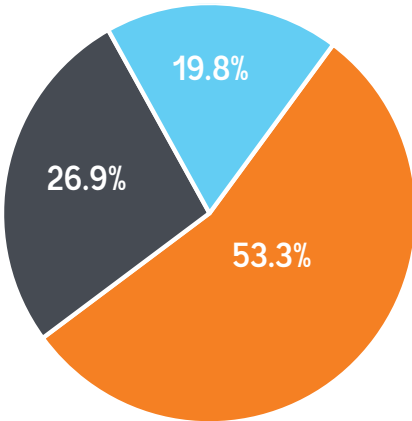

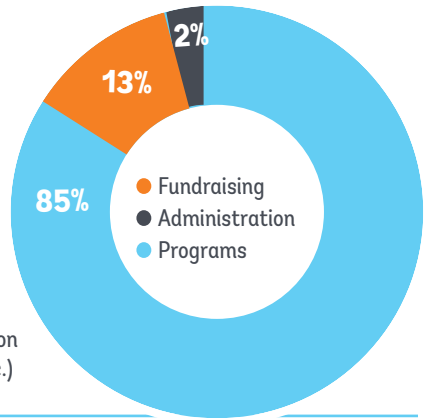


FAMILY EXPENSES PAID

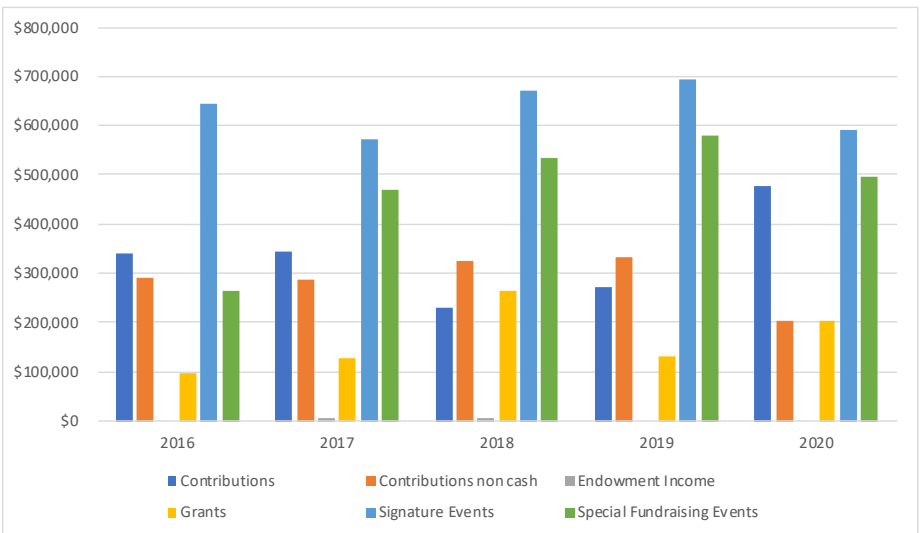
