

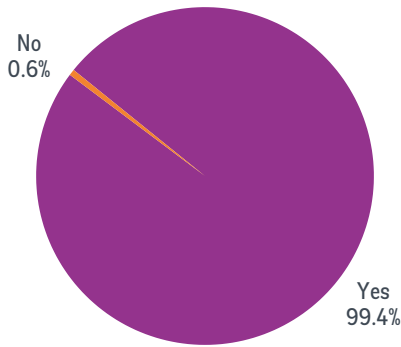


# 2025 LIGHT OF HOPE FAMILY PROGRAM *Survey*

Bringing Hope Home pays essential household bills for Families battling cancer in the Greater Philadelphia Area. Through our Light of Hope Family Program, we supported 1,029 Families in 2025 with rent and mortgage payments, as well as monthly household utility bills, car payments, car insurance, cable, internet, and phone bills, and supplied grocery gift cards.

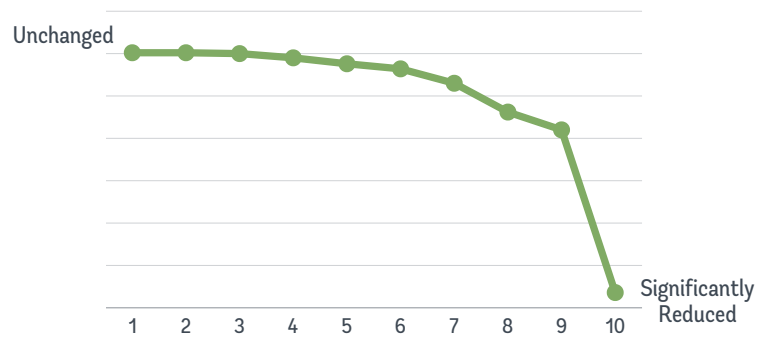
We reached out to all of our Families assisted in 2025 and asked a series of questions aimed at measuring the financial and emotional impact that our support had on them, specifically on their stress and healing. Below are the results of our survey received from 30% of the survey recipients.

### 1.) Once approved, was your application processed in a timely manner?



“This program helped our family exactly at the right moment. My husband is a teacher, and we do not receive income during the summer. As the end of August into the beginning of September is our most affected time, the grant eased our financial stress, and we were able to apply the funds toward our September mortgage payment. It was a relief not having to worry about scraping up money to make this payment.” - A BHH Family

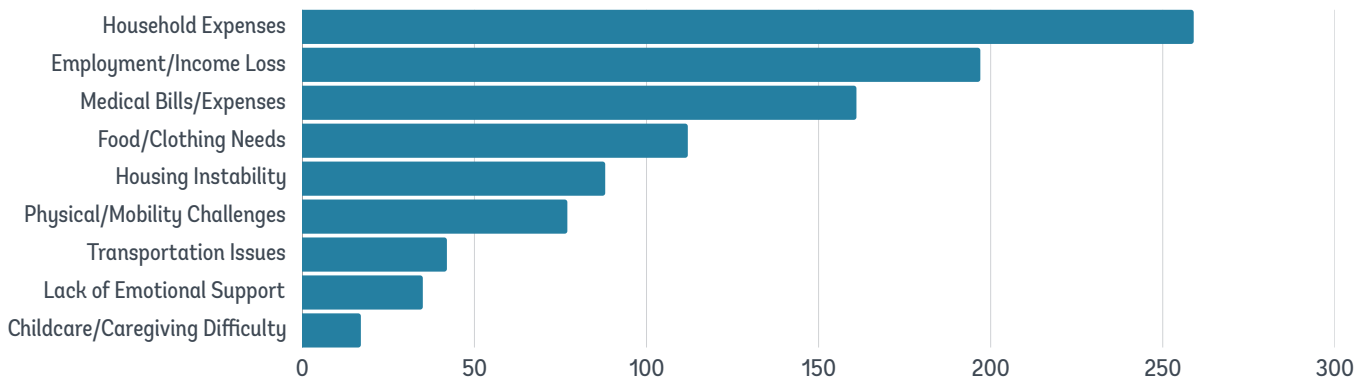
### 2.) After receiving financial support from Bringing Hope Home, my stress was:



“The financial gap was my biggest stressor, but Bringing Hope Home relieved me of that burden by helping in times when I had no one else to turn to financially. They made me forget, even if just for a moment, that I had cancer because my kids and I were able to pay our rent and breathe a little easier.”

### 3.) What are the top three obstacles you have faced during your cancer journey?



“Our rent was paid for December which allowed us to pay our other bills. This helped not just physically but also emotionally. I am the only one with income at this time and we also have a 14 year old son. I was able to buy his shoes and clothes that he needed without having to figure out how to pay the rent this month. The gift cards we received will also help us to have food for the month.”
