Bringing Hope Home® is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing financial support to individuals and Families affected by cancer in the greater Philadelphia area. Last year, through our Light of Hope Family Program, BHH supported over 1,000 Families facing challenges during cancer treatment by covering expenses such as rent, mortgage, and utility bills. Since our inception in 2008, we have helped more than 11,000 Families with over \$13 million in direct financial support. There are many ways your hospital or cancer center can help further our mission to provide Unexpected Amazingness to Families in need.

HOSPITAL PARTNERSHIP

Bringing Hope Home is now offering a Hospital Partnership Program that allows hospitals and cancer centers to refer additional Families in need to the Light of Hope Family Program for support. Through this partnership, social workers can increase the number of Families that they can refer to BHH's program.

HOW IT WORKS

- Light of Hope Family applications are accepted on the 1st business day of each month. Our BHH Family Department team connects with every Family to discuss their needs and to ensure our funding helps in the best way possible.
 - The BHH Family Department works closely with the referring social worker to ensure all Families are assisted in a timely manner.
 - Applications are processed 1-3 weeks of submission.
 - Payments are generated in the form of a check and mailed directly to each prospective vendor.
 - Once the Family's application has been processed, BHH generates a summary of bills paid and an invoice for half of the Family's total assistance and emails the information to the hospital partner for reimbursement. There is also an option to prepay for the year.
 - BHH send a cobranded letter to the Family and referring social worker, advising them which vendors were paid, the dollar amount, and all check information so that the Families and social workers are aware of the support provided by both BHH and the hospital partner.
- *Recognition by the hospital partner on the Family follow-up letter is optional.

 - This Program is available to all hospitals, cancer centers, and health systems that BHH currently works with.

The Hospital Partnership Program allows us to serve the ever-growing need and deviates from having a Family being placed on a wait list for services that can be of an urgent matter.
